CHURCH REGISTRATIONS

Church teams will consist of 10 players per team (Please complete separate registrations for Junior Teams and Senior Teams). The Church Team will be required to submit the main church registration form, team member registration forms, and their coach registration form(s). Each church should assign a coach for their team from their local congregation (teams can have a Head Coach and an Assistant Coach). All guidelines, scheduling, and game details will be communicated directly to the Head Coach for each team.

Code of Conduct

- Respect fellow players, volunteers, coordinators, officials, coaches, and parents.

- No profanity or violence of any kind will be tolerated!
